

To all ASI Members,

At the beginning of October we will begin a project to greatly expand our glider and glider trailer tiedown areas and to bring them up to the standard of the North Tiedowns just west of the main hangar (see attached diagram). For the initial stage of this project, there will be extensive earthwork performed on our East, South, and West glider and trailer tiedown zones. To enable this work, all gliders and their trailers must be removed from these areas by Monday, October 1st. It is more efficient (= way less expensive) to do all the earthwork at once, rather than one area at a time.

During the construction period, only the North and Gazebo tiedown areas will still be available. Glider trailers may be tied down in these areas on a space available basis.

Our Operations Manager, Rob Stone ([rstone118@charter.net](mailto:rstone118@charter.net)) will be in charge of these relocations. You must coordinate with Rob if you wish to leave your glider and/or glider trailer for the winter.

Glider trailers may be parked in the Memorial Grove or the RV parking areas, however, you must bring your own tiedown stakes (and you **MUST** secure your trailer). Please do not park amongst the trees – it is bad for the roots and you are likely to damage the irrigation system.

We know this will be inconvenient for some people for a while, but the result will be very functional tiedowns with enough capacity to accommodate all camps and events plus any growth in gliderport users without requiring musical chairs with trailers.
